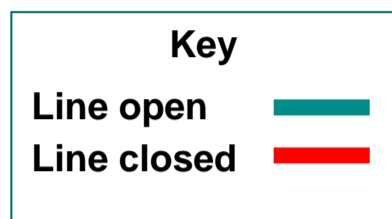

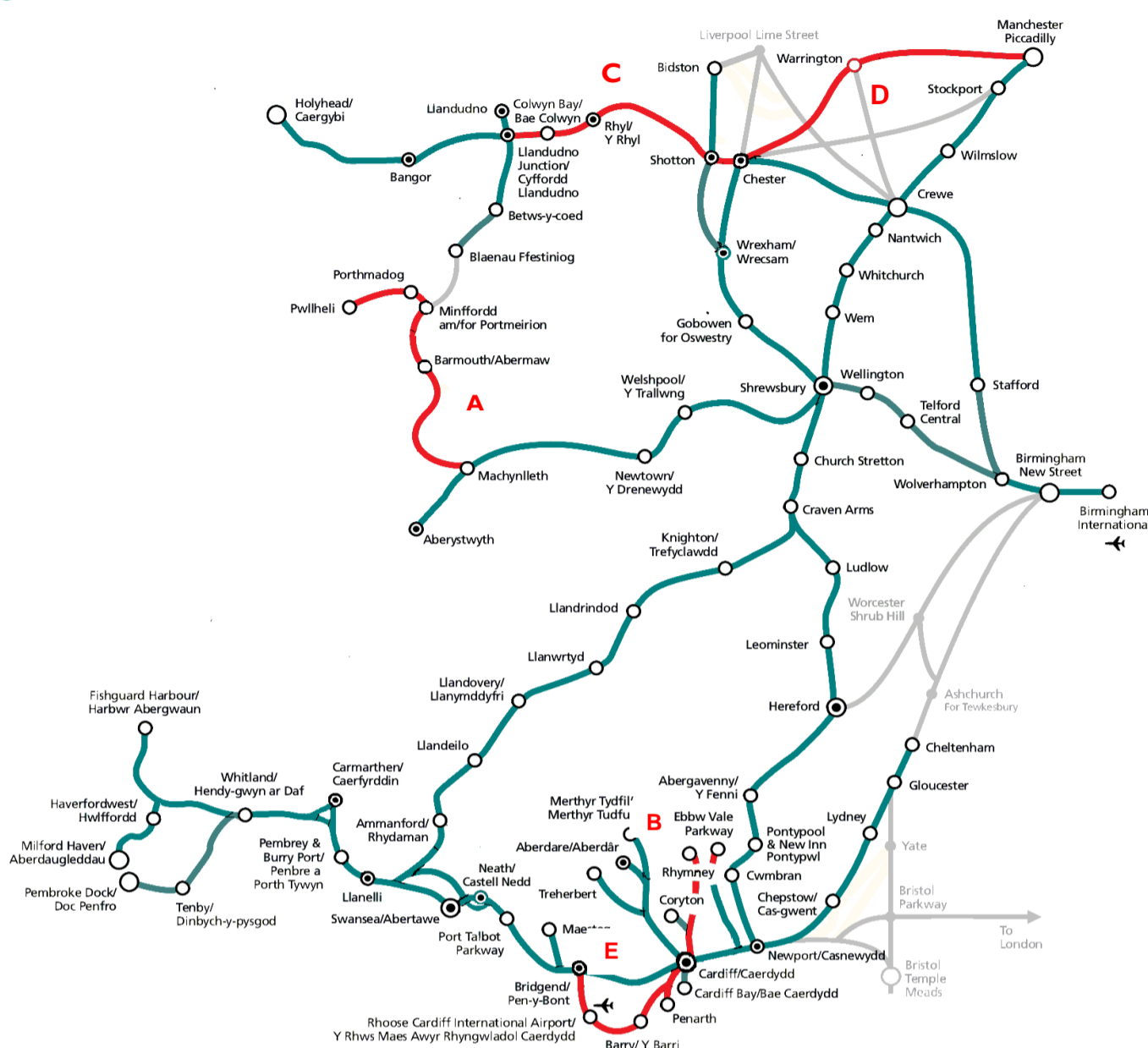


Changes to Train Times



Passengers are reminded that some late night and early morning journeys may also be subject to change across our network and are advised to check before travelling.

Please ensure you have purchased a ticket before boarding rail replacement road transport services.



Major engineering work taking place during November on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below. These are changes to the published timetable. Details of how this may affect your journey will be shown on detailed posters at local stations or visit our website at www.arrivatrainswales.co.uk or call National Rail Enquiries on 03457 484950.

A Machynlleth and Pwllheli.
Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 November.
 A replacement bus service will be in operation between Machynlleth and Pwllheli. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

B Cardiff and Rhymney.
Sunday 5 November.
 Buses replace trains between Cardiff and Rhymney. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

C Chester and Llandudno Junction.
Sundays 5, 12, 19 and 26 November.
 Buses replace trains between Chester and Llandudno Junction. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

D Manchester and Chester.
Sundays 5 and 12 November.
 Train services are diverted via an alternate route and will be unable to call at stations between Manchester Piccadilly and Chester. A replacement bus service will be available calling at all intermediate stations. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

E Cardiff and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend via the 'Vale of Glamorgan'.
Sundays 12 and 19 November.
 All day Sunday, buses replace trains between Cardiff and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

We regret that bicycles, prams and animals (except assistance dogs) cannot be carried on rail replacement road transport.
